The 2-year training position is based at the Ottawa General Hospital, the tertiary level perinatal referral centre for Eastern Ontario serving 18,000 deliveries annually. The successful candidate will be involved in: advanced ultrasound diagnostics using state-of-the-art technology and archiving; invasive fetal testing and genetics, ambulatory clinics featuring medical complications of pregnancy. Development of skills necessary for research scholarship in Maternal-Fetal Medicine will be emphasized.
